Was it possible for the disciples to go buy food for 5000 person?

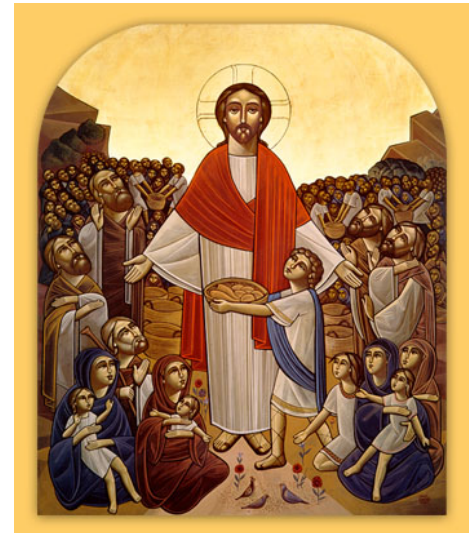
