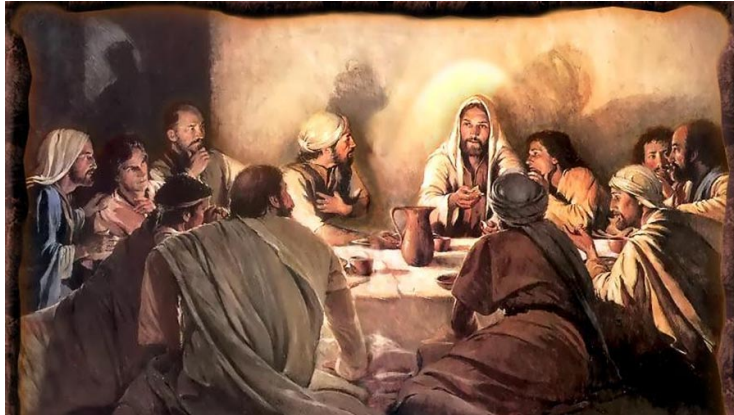

John 13:5&34

Verse: “..Take, eat, this is My body..” Matthew 26:26
