1) WHAT IS THE ST. MARK'S FESTIVAL?

- + It is a Summer Spiritual Competition that originated in the motherland of Egypt under the guidance of His Holiness Pope Shenouda III. Today, Coptic Orthodox churches from all over the world participate in the competition in many different languages.
- + Children and youth will study various **spiritual subjects**, enjoy **sports and other activities**, as well as have a chance to be involved in various **competitions** over the summer.

2) WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

- + The ultimate goal is for all participants to grow in his or her relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ through prayer, fellowship, and reading the Holy Scriptures.
- + There are **many spiritual benefits** to the children and youth who participate they will gain knowledge about:
 - The Bible through Bible Study
 - The Lives of the Saints
 - The Coptic Church's History and Rituals
 - The Coptic Hymns and Coptic Language
- + Children and youth will enjoy a summer of fellowship and fun with their friends in God's house. They will enjoy time with old friends while making new friends.

+ Kindergarten through College age. Children must have completed Kindergarten.

2015 St. Mark's Festival (Mahragan El Keraza) <u>RULES</u>

"He who heeds instruction and correction is (not only himself) in the way of life (but also) is a way of life for others." (Proverbs 10:17)

Parents, please read these rules very carefully and then review them with your children so that they know what is expected of them as well. Please feel free to ask any questions if you need clarification regarding these rules. These rules will be strictly enforced so that all participants may fully benefit and enjoy this spiritual competition.

1) PARENT RULES:

- **Drop-Off & Pick-Up**: For children in **Kindergarten through 8th grade**, parents must come inside the church building to drop-off and pick-up their children each day. For your child's safety, please make sure you take your child to their classroom and be sure that your child is with his/her servant before you leave. Please know the name of the servant with whom you have left your child that day.
- **Sign-In & Sign-Out:** For children in **Kindergarten through 8th grade,** parents must sign-in and sign-out their children each day on the attendance sheets located at the table downstairs. High school and College students may sign themselves in and out.
- Supervision: As noted, practice sessions are Wednesdays and Fridays from 7:00pm 9:30pm.
 Please be aware that servants will NOT be responsible for supervising children BEFORE 7:00pm or AFTER 9:30pm. All children will be released from activities and will be UNSUPERVISED after 9:30pm. Parents are responsible for their children after 9:30pm. If your child will not participate in any sports or other optional activities, your child will need to be picked up before 9:30pm (please see practice schedule for exact times). For your child's safety, please pick up your children on time.
- Parking: Please DO NOT PARK in the Basketball area on Wednesday and Friday evenings.

2) BEHAVIOR:

- Children must be obedient and speak respectfully to each other and to all servants.
- **NO** cheating, fighting, inappropriate language, or inappropriate behavior.
- **Behavior Notices** will be given to parents whose children are refusing to follow rules and are not allowing others to enjoy their time. Behavior notices will be one way for servants to keep parents informed about their children so that they can address these issues at home. Parents and servants must work together to ensure the success of the program.
- After 3 Behavior Notices, parents will be required to attend the next practice session or event with their child or the child will not be able to attend that practice session or event.
- To avoid distracting others and disrupting the class, NO electronic devices of any kind (cell phones, ipads, ipods, etc.) should be used in the classroom while servants are holding practice sessions.

3) PARTICIPATION:

- Required activities for ALL participants: Bible Study/Memorization, Hymns/Coptic, and Bible Exam.
- Optional activities for ALL participants: Sports and Movie/Indoor Games (younger ages).
- To be eligible to participate in any final sports competition, participants must attend 80% of all practice sessions (4 absences) and obtain a passing score on the Bible Exam.

4) DRESS CODE:

- Please remember you are in God's House. Please avoid the following: above the knee shorts, skirts, or dresses, sleeveless shirts, low-cut shirts, or tight-fitting clothing.
- Children should wear their Mahragan El Keraza t-shirt to each practice session and event.

5) FOOD & DRINKS:

Children are required to bring a snack and water bottle labeled with their first and last names to each
practice session.
